Why should I register and become a member of the parish?

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. Membership requires signing up and formally enrolling yourself in the parish. But it is also more than just filling out some forms.

Here are the reasons:

- --- Registering in the parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of our parish. As parish members, we are all here to help each other on our spiritual journey; we don't want to do this alone. As much as you need us, we need you too.
- --- It gives you a sense of belonging and identity in a parish community. Together, we express our faith and we give witness to others.
- --- In times of joy and in times of struggle, it is comforting to have the support of a faith family.
- --- It is a commitment to practice your faith. Committing to a parish is much like a commitment to a family, school, or community organization. Just like you want the parish to be there to provide Masses, Sacraments, education programs, and ministries, the parish needs to be able to count on you to help and assist in their mission; to be an active member.
- --- Gives a chance for you and your family to be counted and heard in the parish.
- --- Being included in the demographics of the parish helps in the planning for the needs of the parish and the whole diocese
- --- It gives the parish a way to connect with you.
- --- To receive the Sacraments of Baptism, First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, Confirmation, or Holy Matrimony, you will need to be a registered member
- --- For religious education instruction and Sacramental preparation, the families of those attending must also be registered parishioners

Parish registration creates a two-fold obligation:

On one hand, the pastor is obligated to serve the spiritual needs of that individual. On the other hand, the individual is obligated to support the mission and needs of the parish.




