### **RCIA NEWS:**

On Monday, Jan 12, RCIA participants enter the **Catechumenate** phase of their preparation to join the Catholic Church. This journey is not just about attending a "class" but a time of learning to live the Christian way of life, including prayer, worship and service to others.

During this period, the catechumens and candidates (those already baptized in another Christian tradition) will learn Catholic beliefs and teachings. They will continue to develop their prayer lives, become familiar with Catholic forms of prayer and be active participants in the Sunday liturgy. As well, all are encouraged to engage in all aspects of parish life so to experience the Church as a living community.

Each parish member is essential to this journey. Each of us, inside the Church or in the larger community, should be a witness of faith by our words and actions. Keeping those on this Journey of Faith in prayer is a needed spiritual support. A welcoming smile and a friendly Hello when you meet someone new to the faith is a sign of our mutual commitment to the renewal of our faith and our mutual commitment to living out our Baptismal promises.

This entire process is the Church's ancient way of ensuring that new members are fully prepared in mind, body, and soul for full communion. The presence and conversion journey of the catechumens can lead to a renewal of faith and a deeper understanding of Baptismal promises for all existing parishioners.
