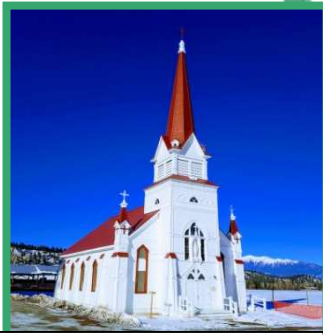
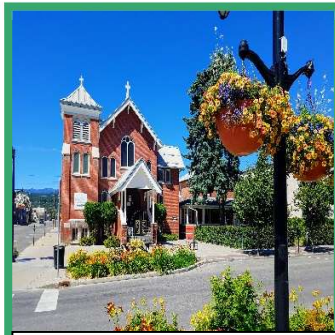

I'll be away in the Philippines from December 30th to January 16th. Please pray that God will grant me a safe journey and a memorable time with my family and friends.

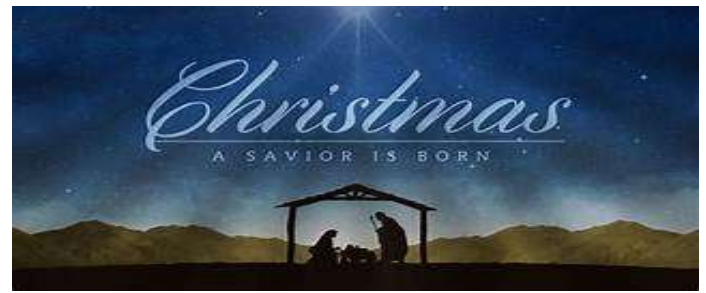
Fr. Julian Studden, a retired priest from Calgary Diocese, will be taking my place. Please warmly welcome him to our parish.
